1. OFFER DESCRIPTION

Our announcement is directed to the person who will conduct own research in the field of application of hydroacoustical techniques to study marine ecosystems including the use of marine ambient noise data for understanding physical, geological, geochemical and biological phenomena and processes.

Tasks of the person employed in the above-mentioned state:

- analysis of collected hydroacoustical data and interpretation of the results,
- application of numerical modelling for interpretation of hydroacoustical measurements results,
- data acquisition during research cruises on a vessel of the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences and other vessels,
- participation in the data base development in the field of conducted research,
- active participation and representation of the Marine Acoustic Laboratory at international and national scientific conferences,
- publishing research results in papers primarily included in the Journal Citation Report (JCR) database,
- actively seeking new forms of research funding in the form of research grants.

Type of contract and job status: full-time employment contract.
